## Home in the Islands A Henry Kapono & Friends Concert is BACK June 18, 2022!

Join us for a memorable night under the stars with over 20 of Hawai`i's most iconic and emerging entertainers, together on one stage, celebrating the songs and the stories of our beloved island home!

More than just a concert, Home in the Islands (HITI) will be one of the state's first major live showcases in more than two years featuring over 20 entertainers!

HITI is projected to inject over \$250,000 into the recently decimated local entertainment industry while helping to provide work for nearly 500 Hawai'i based music industry workforce and related professionals. A welcome endeavor after the devastating effects COVID-19 has taken on the music industry in Hawai'i. Additionally, HITI is a fundraiser for the Henry Kapono Foundation. 25% of the concert net proceeds and \$1 from every ticket donated will support the development and expansion of Grant & Scholarship Awards and Music Industry Programs that benefit the Music Community. HITI serves as a launching point for bringing our communities together in healing and fellowship as we celebrate the music that embodies the spirit of growing up in Hawai'i.

We intend to focus on the Hawaiian value of Mālama Hawai'i, meaning to take care of our Hawai'i, our island home, and our communities. This event focuses on bringing the community together with the vision of growing into an annual Music Festival. An endeavor with the potential to elevate Hawai'i, amplifying the artistry and values of the Hawaiian culture worldwide, while increasing employment opportunities for kama'āina (local) creators and elevate Hawai'i's creative heritage with work opportunities that promote music and the arts.

HITI will take place at the iconic Tom Moffatt Waikīkī Shell, June 18th from 6 p.m. to 10 p.m.

This is the venue of choice for Hawai'i's most legendary concerts and events since established in 1956. With breathtaking sunset views and just mauka of the iconic Le'ahi (Diamond Head), the Tom Moffatt

Waikīkī Shell is housed within Kapi'olani Park, one of the oldest public parks in Hawai'i which was created by King Kālakaua and dedicated in 1877. It has been the location for concerts by legendary Hawai'i musical artists and entertainers such as Izrael Kamakawiwo'ole, Don Ho, Cecilio & Kapono, and Jack Johnson. In addition, many artists worldwide with strong ties to Hawai'i, have also graced the stage, including Elvis Presley. It holds a seated capacity of 2,400 plus outdoor lawn seating for 6,000. We anticipate a completely sold-out event.
